

Projects and student exchanges

1. Duration

- between 5 and 21 days

2. Conditions

- youth exchanges between ages of 13 to 30
- a group leader - at least 18 years old

3. Financial support

- the EU grant supports travelling as well as practical and activity-related costs necessary for the exchanges
